

Teen King Competition Instructions for Judges

1. You will each be given a copy of each Teen King's resume to judge. You will then judge them on community involvement, church involvement, service, awards, general activities and FCRV activities as youth, teen and participation in adult activities.
A. 1 to 25 points will be awarded for the resume.
2. You will be introduced to each Teen King contestant by first name and number. You will be given three (3) minutes to talk to each Teen King contestant about his schooling, hobbies, ambitions, etc. This will give you a chance to meet the contestants and start preliminary judging on personality and communication abilities. We request that you do not ask any questions concerning politics, war actions, racial problems, or religion. The State Teen Directors will be present.
A. 1 to 25 points will be awarded for appearance and communication skills.
3. The Teen King contestants will be involved in some sort of skills competition. You will judge them on their poise and how they do under pressure and adversity. **It does not matter who completes the skills portion first or who is best, just how they handle themselves.**
A. 1 to 25 points will be awarded for poise and composure.
4. During the Teen Queen Evening Gown Portion of the competition, the Teen King contestants will escort the Teen Queen contestants on stage. You will judge them on poise and how they present themselves.
A. 1 to 25 points will be awarded for poise and overall appearance.
5. At the conclusion of the Teen Queen Evening Gown competition and their prepared question segment, the Teen King contestants will be given a final question. **It is more how the Teen King contestant handles the question rather than the answer.**
A. 1 to 25 points will be awarded for overall presentation.
