MICHIGAN FCRV SCHOLARSHIP  
REQUIRED CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP

In following with FCRV National Scholarship guidelines; scholarships are available for FCRV members and/or their children enrolled in **Undergraduate Programs** that meet the requirements listed below:

- 1) Applicant must have been a member of FCRV for past 2 years.
- 2) Must be a member of FCRV in good standing. Candidate must be a Michigan member of FCRV or a member whose Chapter is chartered in Michigan.
- 3) State on application the type of scholarship you are applying for:  
Type "A"            A student who is attending an accredited institution of higher education leading to a Bachelors Degree or greater. A transcript of schooling must be included with application.  
  
Type "B"            A student enrolled in special education courses or attending a vocational program, trade school or institution of higher education in a curriculum not leading to a Bachelors Degree. A transcript of schooling and/or at least one letter of recommendation from the school you are attending must be included with application.
- 4) The candidate must be accepted by an accredited Institution of Higher Education, Trade School or Vocational School. Send copy of acceptance. Any field of study will be considered. Equal consideration will be given to High School Seniors, present students and former recipients of a MSA scholarship
- 5) Re-application for a scholarship must be made EACH YEAR. You must include a copy of grade transcripts and proof of acceptance or registration with your re-application.
- 6) Applicants must have at least a 2.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 grading scale.
- 7) The applicant or applicant's parent must have attended at least one (1) Michigan FCRV campout in the previous year and camp/stayed overnight one night. Qualifying campouts are: MSA State Spring, MSA State Fall and a District Campout.
- 8) If a Scholarship award recipient fails to attend school during the academic year for one full semester/quarter, the award money must be returned to the Scholarship Fund. Recipient must submit a transcript from the school or college at the end of the first completed semester/quarter to the Scholarship Director. Transcripts must be received by February 1<sup>st</sup> of the year following award receipt or return the award. Failure to comply shall render applicant ineligible for future scholarships.
- 9) Judges will score applicants as follows:
  - a) Leadership – 20 Points
  - b) Academic Achievement – 20 Points
  - c) Extra Curricular Activities – 20 Points
  - d) Past FCRV Activities – 10 Points
  - e) Current FCRV Activities – 20 Points
  - f) Personal Resume – 10 PointsApplicants with highest score in each "A" or "B" category will receive an award.
- 10) **June 1<sup>st</sup> is Deadline** for Scholarship applications. All applications that are mailed U.S. Mail must have a post mark date stamp on the envelope to be accepted for judging. Applications emailed will be accepted by the date and time on the email. The Scholarship awards will be announced and distributed at the MSA Fall Campout, typically the third weekend of September.
