MICHIGAN FCRV SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIRED CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SCHOLAR

- 1) Applicant must have been a member of FCRV for past 2 years.
- 2) Must be a member of FCRV in good standing.
- 3) “A” Scholarship applicants - send transcript of schooling with application.
“B” Scholarship applicants - send transcript of schooling and/or at least one letter of recommendation from the school you are attending or attended.
- 4) The candidate must be a Michigan member of FCRV or a member whose Chapter is Chartered in Michigan.
- 5) The candidate must be accepted by an accredited Institution of Higher Education, Trade School or Vocational School. Send copy of acceptance. Any field of study will be considered.
- 6) Re-application for the scholarship must be made EACH YEAR. You must also include proof of acceptance or registration with your re-application.
- 7) Equal consideration will be given to High School Seniors, present students, and former recipients of the scholarship.
- 8) Equal points deciding selection of the scholarship will be based on the following:
 - a) Interest of Candidate.
 - b) Leadership
 - c) Past Activities (scouting, 4H, etc.)
 - d) Past FCRV activities and number of years in FCRV
 - e) Resume
- 8) State on application the type of scholarship you are applying for:
Type “A” A student who is going on to an accredited institution of higher education leading to a Bachelors Degree or better.

Type “B” A student who has attended special education or who is going on to either a vocational, trade school or an institution of higher education in a course not leading to a Bachelors Degree.
