

Chapter Projects Committee Guidelines

- A. All registrations must be sent to and in the possession of the State Project Directors forty-five (45) days prior to the State Campout.
- B. A ten (\$10.00) dollar deposit is required for each eight (8) foot space desired. This deposit will:
 - 1. Be returned to the chapter if they set up at the project sales.
 - 2. Be deposited in the campout funds, as forfeiture:
 - a. If the chapter fails to set up at the project sales.
 - b. If the chapter fails to use all the space reserved, forfeiture on unused space.
- C. The State Project Chairperson is to inform the committee as to the numbers of spaces that are requested at least thirty (30) days prior to the campout.
- D. Project sales at State Campouts are for chapter projects only. If an individual desires to sell, they must do so through the commercial area.
- E. Items to be sold by a chapter shall be:
 - 1. Chapter made.
 - 2. Chapter purchased for resale.
 - 3. Family oriented.
 - 4. If food:
 - a. Those NOT requiring refrigeration.
 - b. Shall be wrapped in the selling size unit.
- F. The first half hour of project sales shall be for handicapped persons **ONLY**. Security shall assist.
