

## **Adult Volleyball Guidelines**

### **State Spring Campout**

- A. FCRV National rules shall apply. Use rules in latest campout planning guide or obtain a set of the latest national rules from the State Director.
- B. All players must be current members of FCRV and the chapter or District which they are representing.
- C. Each team shall consist of a maximum of twelve (12) players, of which the male/female ratio shall be as close to one to one as possible. A team may never have more men than women playing at any time.
- D. All competitors must pre-register by signing up at the campout at the designated times and place, listed in the program booklet. It is suggested that the times be:
  - 1. Friday evening for a couple of hours.
  - 2. If competition is Saturday AM, registration shall be up to thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of competition.
  - 3. If competition is Saturday PM, registration shall be up to twelve (12) noon.
- E. Each team is to be provided a set of rules prior to onset of competition by handing out the rules at registration at the campout.
- F. An award is to be provided to each first place team. This award shall be marked with:
  - 1. The year.
  - 2. Volleyball.
  - 3. MSA-FCRV.
- G. Additional placing awards can be made at the option of the games committee.
- H. The awards are to be supplied by the games committee and paid for from campout funds.
- I. There shall be one (1) person representing the games committee present at all times while competition is under way.
- J. The games committee shall obtain qualified officials as outlined in the rules to conduct the competition. This may mean hiring the qualified officials.
- K. In selecting the site, try to:
  - 1. Have one that is handy to the membership.
  - 2. Have one that is safe to:
    - a. The players.
    - b. The spectators.
  - 3. Have one that is level.
  - 4. Have one that is at least eighty (80) feet in length and fifty (50) feet wide for each playing court to be used.
- L. Assign the playing order by a random method.
- M. Prior to the start of the competition assemble all needed equipment at the playing site.
  - 1. One or more volleyballs.
  - 2. Volleyball net supports and guys.
- N. Prior to the campout, get the MSA equipment from the MSA Trailer.
- O. MSA owns:
  - 1. One (1) volleyball net.
  - 2. One (1) volleyball.
- P. At the completion of competition, the committee chairperson, or person so designated shall:
  - 1. Collect all equipment and return it to the MSA Trailer
  - 2. Record all winners.

3. Report winners, in writing to:
  - a. Campout Chairperson.
  - b. State Director.
  - c. Editor of the Michigander.
  - d. MSA President.
  - e. MSA Secretary.
- Q. At the request of the games committee, the MSA president and/or other(s) designated by the president to discuss the interpretation of the rules for one or more game(s). This meeting can be prior to the campout and/or during the campout, holding the specific game(s), but prior to the beginning of the game(s).
