

Conservation Poster Contest Rules

1. The parents or guardians of the contestants must be current members of FCRV.
2. The contestant's age is to be determined as of July 1st of the year of the contest.
3. Posters must be on standard-sized poster board, approx. 22"x 28" plus or minus ½ inch allowed.
4. Each poster must pertain to some phase of conservation. The poster must be the contestant's own work and must have been created for the FCRV contest only. Any art media may be used.
5. Placed on the **lower left corner of the back side** are to be:
 - A. Contestant's name.
 - B. Contestant's complete mailing address.
 - C. Contestant's birth date.
 - D. Chapter name.
 - E. Field Director's or District Director's stamp.
6. The winning poster will be held by the State Conservation Director for the purposes of taking it to National Campvention for competition at that level.
7. Judging at all levels will be based on:
 - A. Age of the contestant.
 - B. Adherence to National Conservation Board Rules.
 - C. Adherence to or development of the theme.
 - D. Originality.
 - E. Neatness.
8. The posters are to be judged in the following age groups:
 - A. Zero (0) thru five (5) inclusive.
 - B. Six (6) thru eight (8) inclusive.
 - C. Nine (9) thru eleven (11) inclusive.
 - D. Twelve (12) thru fourteen (14) inclusive.
 - E. Fifteen (15) thru nineteen (19) inclusive.
 - F. Twenty (20) years and older.
9. Posters must be checked in at the designated time and location, as designated in the Program Booklet.
10. Contestants need not be present at the judging.
