# SCHOLARSHIP REPORT

I pray all of you are safe and healthy. The holidays are over and it's time to start filling in your camping calendar for the 2021 season with hopes COVID will be pretty much behind us by the time we're ready to get out our campers. I for one sure missed camping last season and seeing all of you!!!

It is never too early to start thinking about your scholarship application and gathering the required documents and attachment. Deadline and requirements are as follows:

- 1) Application deadline: June 1st
- 2) All applications mailed by U.S. mail must have a legible post office marked date stamp on the envelope to be accepted for judging. Applications emailed will be accepted or rejected by the date and time on the email when received not sent by the applicant.
- 3) Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 grading scale.
- 4) The applicant **or** applicant's parents must have attended at least one (1) Michigan FCRV campout in the previous year and camped/stayed overnight one night. The qualifying campouts are: MSA State Spring, MSA State Fall campout and a District campout.

As a reminder since all FCRV campouts were cancelled in 2020 due to COVID-19, the Scholarship board will waive the camping requirement for the 2020 camping season.

**IMPORTANT REMINDER**: Teens living at home planning to attend college or a trade school, upon turning 20 years of age, will need to request a 20-year old honorary membership from the Michigan State Director to apply for a free membership. To be eligible for a National or Michigan FCRV scholarship, you must be a **member in good standing**. (See policy below)

### POLICY: TWENTY-YEAR-OLD HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Any single child of an FCRV member in good standing, may at the age of 20, request of the State/Provincial Director that his/her name be placed on the 20-year-old Honorary Membership List. The name, address, and birth date of the 20-year-old will be provided to the national office through the State/Provincial Directors.
- FCRV will extend the membership of a single child through the age of 24 if that individual is in the military or a student in college or technical school. This extension ceases upon leaving college, release from the military, marriage, or lack of application to the State/Provincial Director EACH year for a membership extension. At the end of the extension period the member must pay for a renewal at the going rate.

# **FCRV** Liability Insurance

The explanation of our liability insurance forwarded from Trustee, Sue Fromholzer, Vice President, Operations: It is available to our chapters, regions, and states during an official campout. Liability insurance is designed to offer specific protection against third-party (another camper) insurance claims, i.e., payment is not typically made for the insured (FCRV and its members), but rather to someone suffering loss who is not a party to the insurance contract.

# **Plastic Cap Recycling Project**

Ready to get involved in a recycling project that is good for the environment? Green Tree Plastics located in Evansville, IN will recycle plastic caps into park benches. All we do is collect, sort, and weigh the plastic caps! Some of us are aware of this project as FCRV in Indiana and Illinois are two states that have had success in recycling and purchasing park benches. There is an additional cost depending on what type of bench we choose which can be accomplished with fundraising.

Our goal is to provide a park bench to the three fairgrounds that have hosted our district campouts for many years: Northern District at Gladwin Fairgrounds; Southeast District at Springfield Oaks 4H Fairgrounds; and Blue Water District at Eastern Michigan Fairgrounds.

Just in the short time we started collecting, we have several boxes full! We will talk about this more during the 2021 MSA State Spring Campout. This is an easy project and will be fun to see what we can do to recycle and turn into a useable product.
