



Spring is in the air which means graduation time will soon be upon us. Time to think about completing your scholarship application and gathering the required attachments.

Scholarship deadline and requirements as follows:

- 1) Application deadline: June 1st
- 2) All applications mailed by U.S. mail must have a legible post office marked date stamp on the envelope to be accepted for judging. Applications emailed will be accepted by the date and time on the email.
- 3) Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 grading scale.
- 4) The applicant **or** applicant's parents must have attended at least one (1) Michigan FCRV campout in the previous year and camped/stayed overnight one night. The qualifying campouts are: MSA State Spring, MSA State Fall campout and a District campout.

Reminder: since a few of FCRV qualifying campouts (See item 4 above) were cancelled in 2021 due to COVID-19, the Scholarship board will waive the camping requirement for the 2021 camping season.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Teens living at home planning to attend college or a trade school, upon turning 20 years of age, will need to request a 20-year old honorary membership from the Michigan State Director to apply for a free membership. To be eligible for a National or Michigan FCRV scholarship, you must be a **member in good standing**. (See policy below)

POLICY-TWENTY YEAR OLD HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

1. Any single child of an FCRV member in good standing, may at the age of 20, request of the State/Provincial Director that his/her name be placed on the 20 year old honorary membership list. The name, address, and birth date of the 20 year old will be provided to the national office through the State/Provincial Directors.

2. FCRV will extend the membership of a single child through the age of 24 if that individual is in the military or a student in college or technical school. This extension ceases upon leaving college, release from the military, marriage, or lack of application to the State/Provincial Director EACH year for a membership extension. At the end of the extension period the member must pay for a renewal at the going rate.

Disaster and Safety Awareness Training

Camping season is finally upon us. Time to load up and move out.

Before we start our camping season, don't forget to do a pre-season/pre-trip inspection on our RV's and tow vehicles.

While performing your inspections and checks they should include your electrical system from your power supply cord, surge protector, breaker box, fuses, and GFI outlets.

Check your propane system starting with your tanks, regulators, furnace, water heater, stove/oven. Don't forget to include your carbon monoxide and fire/smoke alarms and fire extinguishers.

Remember to sanitize your waterlines and replace your water filters.

Double check your tires for wear and tear. Make sure your tire air pressures are good along with the wheel bearings. And check your spare tire.

If you haven't used your BBQ grill since last camping season you may want to look that over to, whether it is gas, charcoal, or pellet.

Anyone carrying or using a generator should make sure they are also in good working order. Fresh fuel, oil, spark plug, circuit breakers/fuses all working properly. Does your spark arrester appear to be in good condition? Look over any extension cords and GFI pigtails that's used with your generator.

With the current cost and possible increasing costs of our liquid gold (fuel), it is more reason to keep our vehicles in the best mechanical shape to be the most fuel efficient possible.

Check your fluid levels on a regular basis and filled to the proper levels.

Keep your engine tuned up.

Have your brake system checked also.

This article is intended to be a friendly reminder of things to look over. Everyone has their own type of vehicle/RV pre-travel checks and inspections that are performed. I'm sure I've forgotten to mention some items to check but this is just a suggested list.

Plastic Cap Recycling Project

We are all still working on our recycling project. Green Tree Plastics located in Evansville, IN will recycle plastic caps into park benches. All we do is collect clean plastic caps free of paper, sort, and weigh the plastic caps! They are then put into heavy, contractor bags for transporting. There is an additional cost depending on what type of bench we choose and can be accomplished with fundraising. A fund has been established for this project. We will be bringing this project to some of our campouts this year to sort and weigh the caps.

Our goal is to provide a park bench to the three fairgrounds that have hosted our district campouts for many years: Northern District at Gladwin Fairgrounds; Southeast District at Springfield Oaks 4H Fairgrounds; and Blue Water District at Eastern Michigan Fairgrounds.
